

Shepherding Parents Take Home

A. For Everyone:

Sense the NEED to have competent, confident and committed parents evangelize and discipling their kids.

B. For the Church – youth and children’s ministry leaders.

1. First Base: Build relationships

- a. Measured by: You know them, they know you.
- b. Key skills: greeting, asking questions, listening, prayer.

2. Second Base: Focus on Truth

- a. Measure by: Parents teaching at home (Bible reading and prayer/family devotions)
- b. Key Skills: Presenting the Gospel, Bible reading, prayer and Biblical worldview.

3. Third Base: Share with the Team

- a. Measured by: Home-Church communication/connection.
- b. Key Skills:
 1. Equipping, providing resources to minister. (time, skill, book ministry participation, etc.)
 2. Encouraging, building the confidence of a parent to engage in discipling their child.
 3. Mentoring- investing in another family.

4. Home Plate: Taking it Home

- a. Measured by: Family Time, Training other families (community outreach)
- b. Key Skills: Family Time

C. For the Parent:

1. Go home and read the Bible and Pray regularly with your family.
2. Cooperation/Communication between home/church.
3. Participate in a Family Time.
