

GOSPEL WHEEL

The Gospel Wheel was designed to be a usable tool for presenting the gospel to the post modern person. You don't have to use an outline. Just start sharing with a person from the Scriptures, starting at any entry point, and let the Holy Spirit use the Word to lead a person to faith in Christ.

At the center, of course, is the gospel. (Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose again.)

The entry points align themselves along two dimensions. The **character** line could begin with a discussion of God's character (love) or man's character (sin). Either entry point gets you to the gospel. You could share along the **action** line, that Jesus' shed blood on the cross provides for our salvation, or the corresponding action of a person, which is to trust (have faith or believe) in Jesus Christ's death for our sins.

If a child is ready to accept the free gift of salvation, allow the child to pray in her own words.
