

The Gospel Wheel was designed to be a usable tool for presenting the gospel to postmodern people. You don't have to use an outline, although there is one within the model. Just start sharing with a person from the Scriptures starting at any entry point, and let the Holy Spirit use the Word to lead a person to faith in Christ.

At the center, of course, is the gospel. (Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose again.)

The entry points align themselves along two dimensions. The **character** line could begin with a discussion of God's character (love and holiness) or man's character (sin). Either entry point gets you to the gospel. You could share along the **action** line, that Jesus' shed blood on the cross provided for our salvation, or the corresponding action of a person, which is to trust (have faith or believe) in Jesus Christ's death for our sins. Start anywhere, but get to the gospel!
