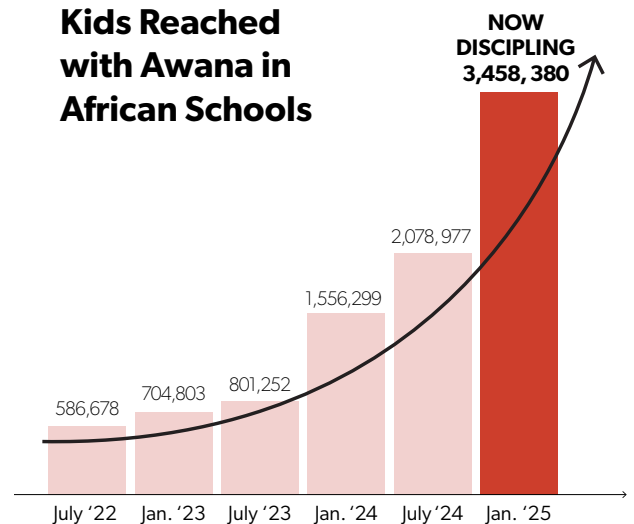
Last year Excellence in Giving™ conducted an impact study of the African Child & School Initiative; just look how boys and girls grow when they experience discipleship in school! Reports show:

- 95% of students are more likely to regularly attend school
- Significantly fewer physical and verbal fights in school
- Percentage of boys and girls who view adults as "safe" rose from 76% to 91%

This is what our shared mission is about. It's about children learning God's Word, knowing who He is and seeing the fruits of a relationship with Him. Jesus changes everything. And He's doing that in over 8,000 schools in Africa. Praise God!

Fill Classrooms With the Hope of Jesus

In the Central African Republic (CAR), we've been invited by the government to bring biblical curriculum into the entire public school system. Training was requested for 400 schools this past January alone. Our goal, set through prayer and intentional conversation, is to equip **700 schools in the CAR for child discipleship by June 2025**.

Why so much, so quickly? Imagine the Bible being welcomed on a scale of this magnitude into U.S. schools; it would, almost certainly, only happen under Christ-accepting government leadership. A change in leadership could bring programming to a halt. In the CAR — in fact, in many of our partner countries in Africa — the political climate is significantly less stable. That's why it's vital to train and provide discipleship materials to as many schools as possible, as soon as possible. The window is open now.
