Thank you for your commitment to spreading the hope of Jesus to some of the most unexpected places — public schools — and for helping us move the Gospel forward in ways like these:

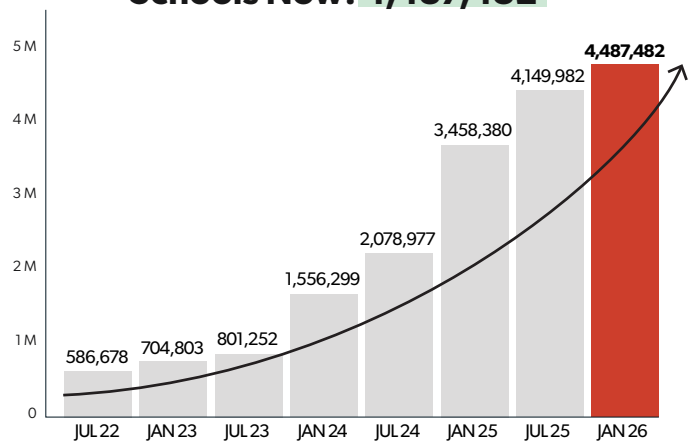
- At this very moment, native language materials are preparing to print and be used for training in the French-speaking countries of Chad, Guinea and Burundi.
